

## Spring 2018: Assemblage with Found Objects

Combine vintage photos, trinkets, and bits and bobs with glue to make a 3-D box assemblage. Create a family heirloom. In this class you will make two assemblage pieces using an Altoid tin and a cigar box or other wooden box. Try out a new genre. Use up your “good junk”.

### You will need:

\*Altoid tin

\*Sm. picture frames with glass that will fit over the Altoid tin

\*Cigar box or other wooden box

\*Glue E-6000 (sm tube at Family Dollar) \*paper towel

\*ruler \*Paper cutter (optional) water containers

\* scissors \*assorted acrylic paints

**\*Keepsakes-** trinkets, buttons, old jewelry, beads, ribbon, lace

**\*Paper-** photos, maps, newspaper, vintage stamps, movie tickets, scrapbook paper, children’s art

**\*Other stuff-** marbles, small toys, doll parts, ruler, cloth tape measure, use your imagination

\*\*\*\*If you plan to use family photos and other personal papers, please make copies (quick print) in advance and bring them to class

**Wear work clothes and bring a lunch (depends on location).**
