Class/Workshop: Assemblage with Found Objects



Combine vintage photos, trinkets, and bits and bobs with glue to make a 3-D box assemblage. Create a family heirloom. In this class you will make two assemblage pieces using an Altoid tin and a cigar box or other wooden box. Try out a new genre. Use up your “good junk”.

You will need:

- *Altoid tin
- *Sm. picture frames with glass that will fit over the Altoid tin
- *Cigar box or other wooden box
- *Glue E-6000 (sm tube at Family Dollar)
- *paper towel
- *ruler
- *Paper cutter (optional) water containers
- * scissors
- *assorted acrylic paints
- *Keepsakes- trinkets, buttons, old jewelry, beads, ribbon, lace
- *Paper- photos, maps, newspaper, vintage stamps, movie tickets, scrapbook paper, children’s art
- *Other stuff- marbles, small toys, doll parts, ruler, cloth tape measure, use your imagination
