### **Paint**

Watercolor Paints:

Suggested Watercolor Palette, both brands are available online at Blick Art Materials.

If you are on a budget Blick watercolors are also a good buy.

Ultramarine Blue	Transparent Mars Brown
Cobalt Blue	Cad. Yellow or Yellow Light
Payne's Gray	Naples Yellow
Phthalo Green (Yellow Shade)	Permanent Yellow Deep
Viridian Green	Sandal Red
Burnt Sienna Deep	Verzino Violet
DaVinci Violet	Primary Blue Cyan
DaVinci Orange	Turquoise Green
Opus	Permanent Green Deep

\*Do not feel that you need to bring the exact colors or even the same brand, this is simply my choice for a well-rounded color palette for studio work. You may bring your own colors.

### **Brushes**

1" Flat brush or 1.5" flat

#12, #8 Round

Smaller brush for finer detailing

### **Paper or Support:**

Watercolor: Arches Rough Press 140 or 300lb, or Fabriano Cold or Rough Press 300lb

**Other Materials to bring include**

- Paper Towel
- Board or support to mount your work- Something rigid you can tape your paper to
- Masking tape
- Palette for your paints
- 2 Water Containers
- Layered clothing for going outside
- Sketchbook
- 6B, 2B and HB pencil.
- White Polymer Eraser or Kneaded Eraser
- Camera or phone to take reference photographs
