Titanium White

Carbon Black or Ivory Black

Cadmium Lemon, Cadmium Yellow Deep, Yellow Ochre,

Cadmium Red Medium, Permanent Alizarin Crimson

Dioxazine Purple

Ultramarine Blue, Phthalo Blue Green Shade, Cerulean Blue

Cobalt Green Light, Chromium Oxide Green

Raw Umber, Burnt Umber

IF YOU ARE NOT SURE OF THE COLORS YOU ALREADY OWN, BRING THEM THE FIRST WEEK AND WE CAN GO THROUGH THEM TOGETHER

OTHER SUPPLIES:

Palette with large mixing area, with wells for watercolor or gouache

Palette knife, small

Paper: Acrylic or gouache: pad of white Bristol Board, vellum or rough surface

Watercolor: pad of watercolor paper

Scissors, glue stick, water container

paper towels or soft cotton rags

Notepad and Pen for notes

Brushes: A variety of brushes: filbert, bright and round, # 1 to # 6. (You can buy the cheap brands), use watercolor brushes for watercolor or gouache
