## STUDENTS to BRING:

- Beach stone a 1/2" to 1" round or oval beach stone that is somewhat flat on the bottom. Stone can be raw or polished. Raw stones can be "polished" with wax prior to setting.
- Any glasses needed for close work
- Any jewelers pliers you have (jewelers pliers are smooth on the inside)
- Apron if available
- Please wear older clothes was much of this work is messy and some involves acid
- Sack Lunch. Feel free to use the microwave or refrigerator in the kitchen on CTAC on the main floor.

## SUPPLIES PROVIDED:

Use of all of the tools needed to make a beach stone ring. An instruction handout covering the construction process, definitions and key tips and information. All workshop supplies needed for this project. This includes fine silver bezel wire, flat sterling silver to back the stone, an adjustable sterling ring mounting (sizes 6 1/2-9), solder, pickle, flux and polishing materials. A material fee (\$20-\$30) to cover the silver used by each student is payable to the instructor.

COVID- Class size is limited to ensure social distancing. Students from the same household may share tools. There is some equipment that is shared with all students (grinder, torches). Wipes will be available to clean supplies throughout the workshop.
