- Pursuing fields of study in the arts. This includes visual arts, performing arts, theatre, dance and music.

Crooked Tree Arts Center focuses on youth arts education through the CTAC School of Music, CTAC School of Ballet, Annual Youth Arts Festival, Annual Youth Arts Show, Annual Young Writers Expo, Docent School Tours, and a wide variety of classes and workshops throughout the year.
